Interpol appears to have a crime problem

Interpol seems to have a crime problem. Ghislain Nagui, the founder of the Abraim Group, faces possible extradition to the U.S. on fraud charges, which he says are "ridiculous." He was granted a \$10 million bail Friday, several days after he fled to Japan. His lawyer, Daniel Kapita, said at a London hearing last week that "nothing" an Interpol hearing officer would prevent him from arrest, he was writing.

Nagui, the founder of the Abraim Group, faces possible extradition to the U.S. on fraud charges, which he says are "ridiculous." He was granted a \$10 million bail Friday, several days after he fled to Japan. His lawyer, Daniel Kapita, said at a London hearing last week that "nothing" an Interpol hearing officer would prevent him from arrest, he was writing.

Nagui's arrest occurs two of the eight people tried a year ago as trustees of the foundation he left behind — a quarter of the board of the organization whose stated mission is to "serve international justice."

Also arrested, Carlos Ghosn, who was arrested in November on charges he called "ridiculous," was a trustee of the same body. He resigned in January, his spokesman said.

And Interpol's former President Meng Hongwei was arrested in China in October on allegations of accepting bribes and accepting other state favors, in a probe that's put a spotlight on China's opaque legal system.

There's a presumption of innocence ahead of any trial. But the arrests are "just another episode that raises questions of transparency and just another chief executive officer of this major transnational group," Interpol has an

important role to play in the fight against serious crimes, which is made harder when people linked to the organization are being put under investigation.

When Ghosn and Nagui became members of the board, both had "an impeccable reputation and a large recognition in their field of activity," the foundation's Director General Georges Zebda said by email. "As soon as some concerns [sic] Mr. Ghosn and Mr. Nagui were raised, the foundation has acted diligently in order to protect its reputation and to take adequately into account the presumption of innocence," he said.

A spokesman for Nagui wouldn't speak to reporters, but has previously said that he remained in the U.S. "to help" and expected to be "held charitable."

Ghosn, who's charged with facilitating evasion of dollars from Nissan Motor Co. through an intermediary for his own purposes, has asserted his innocence and said he'd "vigorously" defend himself.

Meng's wife, Geeta, says her husband is being pursued by the Chinese media, particularly in the field of the law, she said in March.

PASPORTS

Interpol passports, like the one Nagui was carrying, are designed to make officials travel quickly for work purposes without needing visas.

"They're designed for international travel so it makes these documents easy, but many would have been surprised to learn that they appear to also have been issued to members of the board of the Interpol foundation," said Thomas Gauvin in London.

An Interpol spokesman said the passport could be issued to the organization's members "in liaison with travel specifically in relation to activities conducted in the Interpol Foundation." Ghosn's spokesman said he didn't have one.

The Interpol Foundation is a separate, law-based entity that's funding Interpol programs with \$10 billion euros (\$136 million) over a five-year period, under an agreement between the foundation and the UAE government.

PRESIDENTIAL CONTROVERSY

Interpol's decision to nominate the Law, Paris-based body as it emerges from a deeply political battle for an presidency. The U.S. and other Western countries last year warned that Russian candidate Alexander Prokopchuk could abuse his position to harass political opponents. South Korean Kim Jong Yang was selected as its president.
